The man who started it all...

The initial FTGCC failed in 1887/88, resulting from the effect of Grimwood luring its two best players to his 'Glenfern Cricket Club'. He soon renamed his club (at the 1889 AGM) the 'Ferntree Gully Cricket Club', which we still know today. He presided from 1887/88 until 1894/95, however as the 1895/96 season began, Grimwood passed away in Office. Despite his loss, his influential ties with Melbourne's business community ensured regular matches were on our playing calendar and the Ferntree Gully Cricket Club's future was assured.
